

Sudan Initiatives Supported by Episcopal Diocese of Albany

HealthLine Sudan in Yei- This initiative is to support the medical clinic and continue to support the building of the new “Martha Clinic”. The old clinic building will be used for preventive care and the new building will be for diagnostics and treatment. At the present time Poppy Spens is the mission partner who is associated with CMS-I (Church Mission Society of Ireland) and has set up the old clinic which is presently running and soon to be moved into the new building.



Vocational Training College in Yei- This initiative is supporting a training school for students to learn carpentry as well as auto mechanics. The students also can take a course to obtain their driving license. Women learn craft making, baking and sewing. John Spens is the mission partner associated with CMS-I and lives in the compound with his wife Poppy.



The Bethsaida Clinic in Maridi- This initiative is to continue supporting Primary Healthcare in the Maridi Diocese. This clinic is next to be upgraded to the quality of the Martha Clinic in Yei using the existing building and addition you see below.
